3 Rules

Be Safe.

Be Respectful.

Be Responsible.

These guidelines were determined, decided upon, and discussed by the students.

Some **BE SAFE** Guidelines

- Keep objects and body parts to yourself.
- Take precautions. Think before you act.
- Adults need to know where you are at all times.

Some **BE RESPONSIBLE** Guidelines

- Do and turn in your schoolwork and homework.
 - Be on time.

Some **BE RESPECTFUL** Guidelines

- Listen.
- Use polite words, manners, and voice.
- Raise your hand to obtain the teacher's attention.
- Take care of self, each other, objects, and your surroundings.

Consequences

1. Warning: Verbal or non-verbal
2. If repeated offense in same category (or extreme case) a "ticket" will be issued. The student is required to pay off the "fine" and meet the two day deadline. The student will discuss with the teacher (probably during a recess) a logical consequence that matches the situation. Example: If a student is being disrespectful to another classmate by calling her names, an apology letter may be appropriate. It will be different for each student and circumstance.
3. A ticket needs to be paid off by Friday or the student will not be able to participate in special Friday recess. If given a ticket on Friday, the student has until the following Tuesday to meet the requirements.
4. If a conflict occurs between two or more students, time will be allotted for them (recess, computer, lunch detention, etc.) to fill in the Self-Defense Form. They will then discuss the situation and find a solution together. If repeated situations and conflicts (3 forms) occur, parents/ guardians will be notified.
